

The Santa Claus Town Council & Santa Claus met in special session on November 2, 2020 at the Santa Claus Town Hall located at 90 N Holiday Blvd Santa Claus, In.
The meeting was called to order by President Michael Johannes at 4:03 pm.

Town Council Present: Jason Little Michael Johannes, & Seth Windell
Town Council Absent: Kevin Burke & Patricia Vaal
Also, Present: Clerk-Treasurer; Kelly Greulich

Kelly Greulich stated she has an invoice for the Santa Claus Lincoln Discovery Trail in the amount of \$ 22,402.23 that must be paid, the funds normally used for the town's 20% have been expensed out from 444 EDIT/CEDIT there is still some monies left in the CT Trail fund but not enough to cover the full amount. I need the council to make a decision on what funds will the town be using for the remainder of 2020 to pay the town's portion of the current trails. Greulich recommends to the council to use the \$ 25,000.00 in CCI funds and \$ 10,000.00 of Rainy-day if need be.

Seth Windell stated if I remember correctly a couple years ago the council stated they would not spend CCI money on trails. Greulich stated we only have a few funds we can use to pay for the trails and the council has already spent \$ 148,000.00 on the new field at Yellig that would have been a possibility for the trails. A decision does not have to be made today but at least at the November 9th meeting.

Greulich stated currently Kevin Patmore is looking over a contract from Atlas Collection for the town on the delinquent accounts.

Greulich stated Danita Grosvenor is wanting clarification if the council wants her to pursue quotes for dependents and or spousal or spousal carve out on health insurance. Johannes stated we can look at the information and go from there.

Jason Little made a motion to explore the insurance for dependents and family and Seth Windell seconded the motion.


Johannes stated a quick update the Americas Christmas Hometown is looking into a fireworks show that would be held in the Holiday World parking lots. More information will be coming in the near future.




Seth Windell made a motion to adjourn the town council meeting at 4:15 pm and Jason Little seconded the motion.






